Nancy Sprowls Named Trustee Emeritus

It is with deep appreciation that Brunswick ACT has named Nancy Sprowls as a Brunswick ACT Trustee Emeritus. Nancy is currently the Executive Director for Medina County Arts Council. She previously taught theatre, speech, and debate and served as the English Department Coordinator at Brunswick High School. She directed several productions each year and coached the speech team. She retired in 1994 after 28 years in the classroom. She also taught creative dramatics for the Brunswick Recreation Department and directed children’s plays for the Summer Theatre program at the high school. She has directed and assisted community theatre productions with Brunswick ACT for 20 years and has served as Secretary and Artistic Director for ACT.

During her career she has held office in many regional theatre organizations including Ohio Educational Theatre Association/Ohio Thespian State Board of Directors, Ohio Theatre Alliance , Ohio Alliance for the Arts Education, Magical Theatre Company, Medina County Performing Arts Foundation, and Ohio Department of Education Advisory Committee for Arts Education Standards.

Some of her honors include Educational Theatre Association Hall of Fame, Ohio High School Speech League Hall of Fame, National Forensic League Diamond Coach, Ohio Speech Teacher of the Year, and Brunswick School District Teacher of the Year.

Nancy’s support of the arts, and in particular the theatre, is unparalleled. We, the members of Brunswick ACT, and the community thank her for her service and her devotion to Brunswick dramatists and all artists.

Trustee Barbara McGreer has recently been elected to the Medina County Arts Council. The group is an umbrella organization for all the arts in the county.
